Ilana Savdie was raised in Barranguilla, Colombia and Miami, FL, and is currently based in Brooklyn, NY. She received her MFA from the Yale School of Art in 2018 and a BFA from the Rhode Island School of Design. Savdie was a recent participant in the 2022 Emerging Artist Residency Program at Horizon Art Foundation, Los Angeles, and a fellow in the NXTHVN Fellowship Program in New Haven. Savdie is recognized for her surreal and electrifying beeswax, acrylic, and oil paintings which invert traditional associations of figuration and composition. Her distinctive style employs the transformative power of performance as a vehicle to displace control, embrace the grotesque, and dismantle ideas of binary identity relating to migration, foreignness, and familiarity. In 2023, Savdie presented her first museum solo exhibition, Radical Contractions, at The Whitney Museum of American Art.
