Faris Heizer works within the tradition of figurative painting, based on personal observations of contemporary society and its structural workings revolving around capitalism. In particular, Heizer gives form to the behavioral and performative aspects of social relations that arise from such. His artistic inquiries often feature the white-collar worker in a range of imagined realities charged with intimacy, tension, and bewilderment.

In 2018, Heizer graduated from Nanyang Academy of Fine Arts, Singapore, with a degree in Fine Arts, and has had successful exhibitions at Cuturi Gallery such as his recent solo show, *Crooners*, in 2022. He has since participated in several group exhibitions including Tang Contemporary in Beijing, Galerie LJ in Paris, At The Table Group Show hosted by Christie's and Harpers Gallery in New York and most recently, Kristin Hjellegjerde Gallery in Schloss Görne, Germany.
